What is IASIS Microcurrent Neurofeedback?

IASIS Microcurrent Neurofeedback is a gentle, noninvasive, drug-free technology that helps the brain and nervous system move toward balance. It has been shown to support improvement with concerns such as stress, anxiety, depression, ADHD, trauma, concussions, sleep difficulties, and more.

When the brain is affected by stress, illness, or injury, its natural patterns can become “stuck,” leading to symptoms that affect daily life. IASIS uses a brief, harmless microcurrent—delivered through an FDA-registered EEG device—to create a temporary change in brainwaves. This helps release unhealthy patterns so the brain can function more flexibly and efficiently.

Unlike talk therapy, IASIS does not require effort or participation from the client. Sessions are quick, the stimulation is imperceptible, and over time many people experience lasting improvements in regulation, clarity, and overall well-being.

Job Duties

Neurofeedback Support & Client Care

- Provide IASIS Microcurrent Neurofeedback sessions to clients under the supervision and training of a certified provider.
- Ensure client comfort and safety during each session, offering a warm, calming presence.
- Maintain accurate session notes and documentation.
- Prepare and clean treatment spaces before and after sessions.

Administrative & Office Support

- Answer incoming phone calls and return voicemails in a timely, professional manner.
- Respond to emails with clarity, warmth, and excellent customer service.
- Assist with scheduling, rescheduling, and confirming client appointments.
- Maintain organization of office and neurofeedback supplies.
- Support the team with general administrative tasks and any additional office needs as they arise.
- Open and close the office independently, ensuring the space is prepared before sessions begin and securely shut down at the end of the day.

Professionalism & Team Collaboration

- Communicate any client concerns, scheduling issues, or equipment needs to the clinical associate promptly.
- Participate in required trainings, team meetings, and ongoing learning related to neurofeedback and client care.
- Uphold client confidentiality and adhere to all clinic policies and procedures.
